Father John's Reflection

Father John Brosmer is the first person I heard mention Ash Wednesday as "a holy day of opportunity." Following that initial reference, I heard several people mention Lent is the season of opportunity. As an amateur wordsmith, my ears perk up when I hear a change in nomenclature. It wasn't until Ash Wednesday arrived, I understood what that opportunity represents. The faithful people of Jesus Christ long with their hearts to be more Christ-like. In one day, Saint Isidore became the place where **745 penitents** came to celebrate their Catholicity. They walked away marked physically with a black cross on their forehead: in their hearts, the transformation began, the opportunity to become "more."


