



### Father John's Reflection

The Finance Committee of St. Isidore Catholic Parish met on January 18, 2024. Eight of the twelve members were present including the newest appointee, Aaron Atkins, constituting a quorum. Over time, the pastor encourages an attitude of tithing by name. Currently many members contribute generously but not by name. The body voted to proceed with an addition of a main floor bathroom to the rectory financed through donations organized by Kenny Schnell, who has collected \$8,400 to date. \$10,000 is needed with the majority of the labor donated by families of the Parish. Continued pressure on financial performance for the second half of the fiscal year has two sources: the significant shortage of our CMA Bishop's donation of between \$50,000 and \$60,000 payable in 2024/2025 and the unpaid expenses related to the retirement of and the appointment of a new Director of Faith Formation.
