



## **Father John's Reflection**

Jesus suffered and died for us, opening the gates of heaven. We celebrate his Resurrection as proof positive of what awaits the faithful. The fact remains, that we will suffer in mortal life, and how we carry the Cross, and how we help others carry the Cross, truly matters to how we will spend eternity.

Now more than ever, we must protect the young and the suffering, and educate them to the dangers of this world. Part of this is having uncomfortable conversations with those you love. We cannot, in good conscience, be silent in the face of human misery.

According to the Indiana Department of Health, in 2021 over 2,500 overdoses resulted in death in 2021, and nearly 2,000 resulted from the scourge of fentanyl.

Evil people are adding to other compounds to illegals, making drugs cheaper, more powerful, more addictive, and more dangerous. This makes taking anything from the streets extremely dangerous: heroin, cocaine, meth, pills thought to be painkillers, synthetic marijuana, and even marijuana.

According to the Indiana Government Agency Task Force, around 20% of Hoosier High School Students have tried marijuana. Most with no idea that it might be laced with other drugs. <u>If this makes</u> you uncomfortable, it should! What kids think of as harmless could ruin or take their life.

We think of ourselves as rural and not subject to the same dangers as city places, but it's just not true. Dubois County had fentanyl deaths last year, and even our members have had their lives shattered by the effects of illegal drugs.

No illegal drug is safe, EVER. Do not wait; choose this time to talk plainly to your child, your spouse, or your friends. Let us do our part to proclaim this danger to whom we love.

Easter is a holiday affirming a life in Christ.
