





# Reflections from Craig Gehlhausen

On the weekend of April 29th and 30th, not only did we share in the joy of the Scherzinger family with the ordination of Deacon Caleb, the Youth Ministry handed out Popsicles and asked for donations. We started with 360 popsicles and, thanks to the cold weather, have around 200 left. Even though we didn't hand out all of our popsicles we received an enormous amount of support from our parish. We raised a total of \$695 for our students to attend Catholic Heart Workcamp. Thank you so much for your continued support of our students.

A number of our students attending Catholic Heart Workcamp this summer have required sponsorship in order to attend. The registration cost per student is \$400. We have four students who would be unable to attend this year if not for the amazing sponsor couples we have had step forward to help fund their trip. Each of these couples have stepped forward to help pay for our students to attend in amounts from \$100 to \$300. Thank you to all of them. Our students will experience sharing the love of Christ because of you.

Catholic Heart Workcamp is not the only trip that Youth Ministry takes during the year. This November we will be traveling to Indianapolis for the National Catholic Youth Conference. This conference will bring in 15,000 high school students and chaperones from across the country for a three day event.
