Reflections from Fr. John Pfister

How might a Pastor describe the experience of welcoming a deacon into the church? Well, a description wouldn't give it justice; you would just have to be there...and so many people were! From a near capacity crowd at Saint Joseph for the ordination and reception, then a near capacity crowd at Deacon Caleb's first Mass and reception, and finally Sunday's Masses and receptions, at each step, Deacon Caleb, his family, and the community were overflowing with joy. Our joy though is only a first step in a long series of prayers. Prayers that began many years ago.





Imagine how many prayers were prayed from start to finish. Each prayer rising up to God and lifting this young man up to the office of deacon. Deacon Caleb vowed three promises at ordination: celibacy, prayer, and obedience to the Bishop.

Deacon Caleb's mom, dad, and family have made great sacrifices to support Deacon Caleb. Here is their reaction to the ordination: "Words cannot express how proud we are of Caleb as he was ordained a Deacon this morning and watching his first Mass this evening. The amount of people who showed up to support him made this mama's heart SO FULL. The people just kept coming and coming at Mass in Dubois and I couldn't hold back my tears. It takes a village and did they ever show up for him! Thank you so much to our

community, county, and out-of-town supporters. It makes this nine year journey so worth it. Love you all!"

Now my brothers and sisters, we must rise up! We are called to support and pray for Deacon Caleb as he prepares for priestly ordination. Let us storm heaven with prayers to almighty God! The True Presence relies on the success of vocations like Deacon Caleb. As a community, we are united by the love of Christ and love of Holy Mother Church, Salvation awaits!
