



# **Father John's Reflection**

Talk about polarization in the United States has reached a fever pitch; for instance political talk is polarizing. Many people think it's impolite to talk politics among friends and family; is a possible outcome of political talk: an argument, hard feelings, words that shouldn't be said, or words that might be regretted? If you answer yes, then you may realize unity is not a given; unity is something towards which we work. Google explains in a 'word overview': "Unity is being together or at one with something. Unity is the opposite of being divided. Unity is a word for togetherness or oneness."

There is no greater unity in my experiences than the unity of Mass. The Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist fit together like hand in glove. The Holy Spirit rains down on the priest & deacon, the servers, the sacristans, the greeters, the ushers, the readers, the musicians and the congregates. At Mass, love becomes real, and unity is complete; we become the Body of Christ!

"A house divided against itself cannot stand." Talk about Catholicism shouldn't be divisive. The first step in unifying a Parish is for individuals to make the nexus (meaning the deeper link) between individuals' - love (the ability to put others before yourself): this makes God the common denominator for church relationships. It is antithetical for the children of God to refer to "those people," or "them people" within a Parish. The dignity of each human person demands respect and worth for everyone, regardless of the community you live, grew up in, your history, age, or where you worship. To embrace unity leads the individual to reconciliation by granting forgiveness, or asking for forgiveness. For anyone I have disrespected in reality or emotion, please forgive me. For anyone who has slighted me, I forgive you. Give me a call or see me in the confessional if you wish to move towards oneness in your life, personally or in our Parish.
